


Renfrewshire Council - Cultural Organisations Development Fund

Theo Moorman Trust for Weavers - Grants to weavers living and working in the UK

The Theo Moorman Trust for Weavers will be making their biennial grants to weavers in February/March 2024. Grants of between £500 and £5000 are awarded to younger weavers in the early stages of their careers who show potential and commitment as well as to more experienced weavers for a particular project or for time out to develop their work.
